



SUGGESTED TOUR PROGRAMS FOR RFB DELEGATES

Delegates who decide to par-take the tours will make payments individually

1 Day Safari:

Ngorongoro Crater:

Depart Arusha at 6.00am. Enjoy a full day crater tour with picnic lunch taken inside the crater. Take photos of the crater from above upon ascending. Return 7.00pm.

Tarangire or L. Manyara N. Parks:

Depart at 07.30am for a full day tour of the park. Enjoy a picnic lunch at a nice spot inside the park or a hot lunch at Tarangire Safari Lodge, while viewing wildlife. Return 6.00pm.

Arusha National Park:

Depart at 08.00am for a tour of the park. The park is only 30 minutes drive from Arusha town. Enjoy a day game drive until late afternoon.

2 Days Safaris:

Lake Manyara/ Ngorongoro Crater:

Day 1: Depart 6.30am to Ngorongoro for a full day crater tour. Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the crater. Overnight at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge on the crater rim.

Day 2: After breakfast, enjoy views of the crater, then depart to Lake Manyara park for a game drive. Hot lunch at Lake Manyara Serena Lodge. Return 6.00pm

Tarangire/ Ngorongoro Crater:

Day 1: Depart 6.30am to Ngorongoro for a full day crater tour. Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the crater. Overnight at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge on the crater rim.

Day 2: After breakfast, depart for Tarangire for a full day game drive. Hot lunch at Tarangire Safari Lodge. Return 6.00pm

3 Days Safari:

Lake Manyara/ Ngorongoro/ Tarangire:

Day 1: After breakfast, drive to Tarangire for a full day game drive. Dinner and overnight stay at Tarangire Safari Lodge.

Day 2: After breakfast drive to Lake Manyara park for day game viewing. After a picnic lunch and further game viewing, dinner and overnight stay at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge on the crater rim.

Day 3: After breakfast, descend into the crater for a day game drive. Late afternoon depart to Arusha. Return 6.00pm

4 Days Safari:

Lake Manyara/ Ngorongoro/ Serengeti:

Day 1: Morning drive to Lake Manyara Park for day game viewing. After a picnic lunch and further game drive, dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge.

Day 2: Morning drive to Serengeti. Two days in Serengeti. Accommodation at Serengeti Serena Lodge or Ndutu Lodge.

Day 3: Last day in Serengeti. A visit to a Maasai 'boma' –before an early dinner and rest at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge.

Day 4: Early morning descend into the Ngorongoro crater for a full day game drive. Return 6.00pm.

NORTHERN CIRCUIT ATTRACTIONS

The Ngorongoro Crater: 8,288 sq. km

The 8th natural wonder of the world, extraordinary stunning views with a crater floor of 20 km diameter, walls rising 610 meters, Ngorongoro is the largest intact crater in the world. It boasts of the finest blend of landscapes, wildlife, people and archaeological sites in Africa. 20,000 large animals, millions of flamingos on the shores of Lake Magadi, and the endangered black rhino are found here. It is in the midst of all this that the Maasai pastoralists live in harmony with wildlife.

Tarangire National Park: 2,600 sq. km

For bird lovers, Tarangire has more than 550 species of birds recorded. View herds of up to 300 elephants. It is during the dry season that the park has the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem. The park is open savannah dotted with splendid baobab and acacia trees.

Lake Manyara National Park: 325 sq. km

Nestling under the wall of the Great Rift Valley and incredibly beautiful, the park is famous for the tree climbing lions, natural sulphur springs (maji moto), panoramic view of the Lake Manyara, the home of the hippo.

Olduvai Gorge: Features stone tools used by the early man of stone age, animal fossils, skull of Zinjanthropus, a trail of hominid footprints preserved on a bed of volcanic ash all dating back 4 million years. The Olduvai Gorge museum houses a lot of archaeological evidence revealed to the world in 1959 by the family of Dr. Louis Leakey.

Serengeti National Park: 14,763 sq. km

It is at the Serengeti ecosystem where you will witness a spectacular concentration of animals found nowhere else in the world. The peak is during the annual wildebeest migration when over 1 million wildebeest, 200,000 zebras, and 300,000 Thomson gazelles move totally uninterrupted in search of new pastures and watering holes. Catch the eye of the cheetah, leopards and lions on the Kopjes, which dominate the plains. There are hundreds of Crocodiles in the Grummeti River.

Arusha National Park: 137 sq. km

With exception of lions and rhinos the park offers different types of wild life. Sanctuary to hundreds of different species of sedentary or migratory birds. The black and white colobus monkey is the mascot of the park. Hideouts have been created for bird watching.
